

## **Courageous Christians: Stephen**

**Stephen is arrested** (taken from Acts chapters 6 & 7)

Stephen was a man who loved God and was kind and courageous. God was able to use him powerfully so everyone knew Jesus was alive and at work though His Spirit.

'Let's choose Stephen to help us in our work,' agreed the Apostles one day. 'He has received God's Holy Spirit and this has made him brave and kind. He can help us!'
