Teach from the Bible only – you have a gift for teaching and you should use it. Remember you have been anointed to do this. Don't let people speak down to you because you are young, but set a good example in what you say and the way you show love to others and the way you live your life.



Be kind to all, no matter what age they are. Treat one another as family and make sure everyone, especially widows, have everything they need. Lay hands on those who want to stay pure and challenge those who are stuck in sin. Remember, the love of money leads to all kinds of evil and can distract us from our faith. But you, Timothy, are full of love and faith and gentleness. Fight the good fight of the faith! Grace be with you.
