Eternal God, give us insight to discern your will for us, to give up what harms us, and to seek the perfection we are promised in Jesus Christ our Lord.



This week we pray for Resurrection Bikes, a volunteer-run bike-repair missional community, which raises thousands for charity each year. We thank God for John Rowe and Jon Denning from St Mark's, and for the ways in which, throughout 2020, the bike "sales by appointment" scheme not only kept everyone safe but raised an amazing £54,000 for their two charities, Artizan International and In2Out. Pray that, as lockdown eases, this community would demonstrate God's love to many more.
