### **Sun 16th – Sat 22nd Jan**

Eternal Lord, our beginning and our end: bring us with the whole creation to your glory, hidden through past ages and made known in Jesus Christ our Lord.

In this new year, we acknowledge our dependence on God, Alpha and Omega, Beginning and End. Give thanks to God that “He is before all things, and in him all things hold together” (Colossians 1: 17). Thank God that, in Christ, we look ahead to the renewing of all Creation.

Thank God for our clergy, leadership team, and PCC. Let’s pray for individuals by name this week, asking God to equip them, and work through them in building up the life and mission of St Mark’s, and in bringing the good news of Jesus to our community.

### **Sun 23rd – Sat 29th Jan**

God of all mercy, your Son proclaimed good news to the poor, release to the captives, and freedom to the oppressed: anoint us with your Holy Spirit and set all your people free to praise you in Christ our Lord.

individuals to conserve resources and farm in new ways. Help those of us living in plenty to have the grace to live more simply and tread lightly on the earth.

### **Sun 30th Jan – Sat 5th Feb**

God of heaven, you send the gospel to the ends of the earth and your messengers to every nation: send your Holy Spirit to transform us by the good news of everlasting life in Jesus Christ our Lord.

Artizan International has projects in Ecuador and Peru, as well as the UK. We thank you Father for Artizan’s project leaders – messengers of good news, bringing purpose, life and hope to people with different abilities through craft workshops and training.

We lift to God all who are struggling in body, mind or spirit, remembering especially those listed below. Father, bring your peace and healing to each one, and help us as a church family to support and protect the vulnerable and strengthen the weak.
